I. Community Outreach Opportunities

- * Mobile Mammogram Bus was here on September 20, 2016.
- * We had a Flu Shot Clinic on October 20, 2016.
- * We have hosted “3” blood drives this school year. Our senior students who have donated at least 3 times during high school will wear a red cord at graduation.

II. Presentations/Opportunities for students

- * We had a “2” student immunization clinics this year.
- * February is National Dental Month. Levelland Masonic Lodge provided our 1st graders with tooth brushes.
- * The Texas Department of State Health Services Mobile Dental Team came out on February 7, 2017. They did 75 exams, 69 fluoride treatments and 90 sealants. These services were provided free of charge.
